

# FMS Entrance Test

## December 05, 2010



The entrance test for admission into one of the reputed institute of Delhi University - Faculty of Management Studies, New Delhi is conducted at various centres all over India.

This year, around 44,000 students have applied for around 500 seats of various programs of the institute.

The FMS entrance test paper for this year was similar to that of last year. They have not introduced any structural changes in the paper. The paper was slightly easier than last year's one.

In the FMS brochure, it is clearly mentioned that a student must get more than 50 percentile scores in each of the four sections to qualify the test. Call letters to the students would be issued only on the basis of overall percentile score.

An attempt of around 100 questions, with 90% accuracy can be categorized as good, while the cut-off for the test can be expected to be around 345 + marks.

The test, was divided into four sections of 50 questions each, viz. Reading Comprehension (RC), English Usage (EU), Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning (DI-LR) and Mathematical Ability (MA). There was a total of 200 questions in the test.

The detailed analysis of the test is as follows –
