We are please to present you the detailed analysis of Faculty of Management Studies, New Delhi (FMS, Delhi) entrance test held on 13th January 2008.

This year the FMS entrance test paper were same like last year in terms of the total number of questions (175 questions) divided into four sections with surprise elements in terms, no DI & DS questions and different variety of VA questions. The detail section wise analysis is given in following pages.

## Section I

### English Usage

There were total 35 questions in this section. All the questions were on Verbal Ability. There was not a single question on Grammar. There were several new varieties of VA questions. The questions were related to Analogies, Fill in the blanks, Synonyms, Odd one out, Idioms and Phrases and Quotes. The section was of mixture of difficult, moderate and easy questions. Questions on Analogies, Fill in the blanks, Synonyms and all the new varieties were tough. The questions on Idioms and Quote were easy. An attempt of 20 questions with 80% accuracy will be decent for this section.

## Section II

### Reading Comprehension

There were total 40 questions distributed across five RC passages in this section. The theme of the passages were on Psychology, Economics, Sociology and Philosophy. Most of the questions were indirect and tough, although some questions were direct and easy. An attempt of 20 to 22 questions with 80% accuracy will be decent for this section.

## Section III

### Quantitative Ability

There were total 50 questions in this sections. Maths topics like VBODMAS, Percentages, SI and CI, Time, Speed and Distance, Ratio and Proportion, Stocks and Shares, Logarithm, Linear and Quadratic Equations, Plane Geometry, Co-ordinate Geometry, Number System, Mensuration, P & C, Probability and set Theory were the representative of this sections. The overall difficulty level of the section was moderate. Some of the questions of this questions were very easy. An ideal attempt of 30+ questions with 80% accuracy is sufficient for this section. The detail breakup of the section is as follows.

### Logical and Analytical Reasoning

There were total 50 question in this section. The questions were on Syllogism, Statement-Assumption, cubes and Dices, Blood Relations and Data Arrangement. An attempt of 22 to 24 questions with 80% accuracy will be decent for this section.
