**Ideally a student must have spent approx. 15-20 minutes on this part.**

**Section 2 (Logical Reasoning)** : In this section there were total 50 questions were on Analytical and Logical Reasoning. The difficulty level of questions was moderate.

**Ideally a student must have spent approx. 35-40 minutes on this section.**

**Section 3 (Reading Comprehension)** : In this section there were 47 questions. There were 3 passages were there on which 23, 13, 11 questions were asked. The passages given were lengthy.

**Ideally a student must have spent approx. 30-35 minutes on this section.**

**Section 4 (Quantitative Aptitude )** : There were total 50 questions from this section. Most of the questions were on Algebra and Arithmetic. In this section the questions were on permutation and combination, numbers, series, logarithm, base and indices, speed time ad distance, alligation, mixtures, numbers, profit and loss, time and work and averages and circles.

**Ideally a student must have spent approx. 40-45 minutes on this section.**
