

## Gujarat Common Entrance Test

### July 09, 2006

We are pleased to present you the detailed analysis of *Gujarat Common Entrance Test*, held on *July 09, 2006*. The paper was comparatively easy than last year's paper. There were total 250 questions which were from areas like General English, Mathematical Aptitude, Data Interpretation, Data Sufficiency, Logical Reasoning and General Knowledge. There were no separate sections, but the questions from same area were together.

The 60 questions of General English consists of Reading Comprehension and English Usage. There were three small passages in RC on which there were total 15 questions were asked. There total 45 questions on English Usage.

The Mathematical Aptitude section was consist of only 25 questions. A lot of questions were from PT material. Five/Six questions were difficult rest were easy. The questions were from the areas like Number system, Stocks and Shares; Clocks, Work and Time, Profit & Loss, SI & CI.

There were 7 sets of Data Interpretation in the paper. Five questions were asked on each set. Three sets were based on Tables, one on Line Graph and one on Pie Chart. The questions were direct and calculation based. There were exactly two DI sets from PT material. DS was very easy. There were 10 questions. It was 4- Option (Twister).

The maximum weightage was given to this section. In this section there were 60 questions. All the questions were easy. Most of the questions were from PT material or similar to the questions which are given in PT material. Two sets were of Data Arrangement and others were from mixed variety of LR topics.

In General Knowledge there were 60 questions. The questions were from Sports, History, and Business. The bird's eye view of the test is as follows.
