Detailed Analysis

In the following pages we have provided the detailed analysis and some of the actual test questions for your reference.

SECTION I READING COMPREHENSION

There were total 30 questions based on six passages in this section. Passage wise break-up of questions is given in the table.

The attempt of 15-20 question in 25 minutes will be a decent attempt in this section.

SECTION II ENGLISH USAGE

There were total 60 questions in this section. The questions were on Synonyms, Antonyms, Analogies, Identify the errors, Fill in the blanks and Para jumbling, Correct spelling, One word substitution. The level of questions was easy to moderate. The attempt of 30-35 questions in 30 minutes with 95% accuracy will be decent one.

Synonyms of the following words were asked:

PLETHORA, OBSTREPEROUS, LISSOME, COMPASSIONATE, CONTRITE, SLAPDASH, REFRACTORY.

Antonyms of the following words were asked:

HIRSUTE, DEVOUT, DIN, INFIRM, RANCOUR, TANGENTIAL.

Correct spelling of the words like SYNTAX, EMBARRASS, KNOWLEDGEABLE, GRATEFUL, BEGINNING.

SECTION III

NUMERICAL ABILITY

Total 50 questions on various Arithmetic topics like Numbers, HCF and LCM, Percentage, Ratio and Proportion, Geometry, Probability etc. The questions were easy. The attempt of 35-40 questions in 45 minutes with accuracy of more than 95% is decent in this section. The detailed topic wise break-up of Numerical Ability is shown in the adjacent table.

DATA INTERPRETATION

Total 20 questions were on Data Interpretation. There were four sets each containing 5 questions. No major calculations were involved. In most of the questions, calculation of average and percentage change was required. An attempt of 12-15 questions in 15 minutes will be a good one.

SECTION V
DATA SUFFICIENCY

There were 10 questions on Data Sufficiency which were based on the topics of Arithmetic and numbers. Remaining 10 questions were statement-assumption, statement-conclusion and syllogism. An attempt of 10-12 questions in 15 minutes will be a good one.

SECTION VI
BUSINESS JUDGEMENT

In this section, questions were asked not only from business Judgement but also from Data arrangement and decision making. The case given was easy this year. An attempt of around 15 questions in 20 minutes with 95% accuracy will be a decent one.



Overall Analysis

Overall the test was easy to average difficulty level, an overall score of around 414+ should be good enough to get a good institute.
