The written test for admission into the 108 government and private management colleges of Madhya Pradesh (MP) state have been conducted at seven major cities of MP. There were around 20,000 candidate appeared in the test for around 7000 seats of these colleges. As the test begin there were no surprise factor for the students as the pattern was already declared in the brochure and the paper was also on traditional lines. The micro detail of the test is as follows

Section I - English - Total number of questions: 90 - Like last year this year also there were 60 questions on Grammar, Vocabulary and 30 questions on Reading Comprehension. There were total five passages and the themes of the passages were on The History of the dowry system, Comic Books, Dreams, Culture, East Asian arts. In vocabulary there were questions on Synonyms, Antonyms, Analogies, Prefix, Suffix, Homophone, Base word, Different Meaning etc. English Usage consists of FIBs and Para Jumbles. The sections was easy to moderate level of difficulty. A score of 150+ is desirable in this section.

Section II - Numerical Aptitude - Total number of questions: 50 - Although the section was named Numerical Ability, most of the question were on Arithmetic topics like Percentages, Averages, Work and Time, Partnership, Time Speed and Distance, Number Theory, Mixtures and Ratio and Proportion. Some of the questions were on Probability and Logarithm. A score of 105 + is desirable in this section.

Section IV - Data Interpretation - Total number of questions: 20 - There were four sets of DI, which were based on Table, Bar Graph, Pie Chart and Line Diagram. The question asked were easy to moderate level of difficulty and a score of 39 + marks is desirable in this section.

Section V - Data Interpretation (DS) - Total number of questions: 20 - As the DS questions need conceptual knowledge over the subject and there is no need to solve the question or calculate the answer in these questions the section time saving for the candidate who had the very good conceptual knowledge of Arithmetic. A score of 33+ marks in this section is desirable.

Section VI - Business Judgement (BJ) - Total number of questions: 20 - There were two cases in this sections. This questions were of traditional BJ type and one can attempt the one case in this section. So a score of 30+ marks in this section is desirable.
