

## Madhya Pradesh Management Entrance Test June 18, 2006

We are pleased to present you the detailed analysis of *Madhya Pradesh Management Entrance Test* held on *June 18, 2006*. This year again there were 200 questions in MPMET, which were divided into six sections. The sections were Reading Comprehension, Verbal Ability, Numerical Ability, Business Data Interpretation, Data Sufficiency and Business Judgement. As predicted the paper was easy and quite manageable. There were a lot of errata in the paper.

There were four passages. Three of which were long and one was of medium in length. The theme of the passages were on 'Fangshui', 'Survival of Falcon', 'Assembly line industry' and 'Sports'.

In the verbal ability sections there were questions on Para Jumbles, Critical Reasoning, Antonyms and Synonyms, and Analogies.

In Numerical Ability section out of 50 questions, 12-13 questions were on Number system. 10-12 questions on Arithmetic. Four questions on Geometry and rest of the questions from other areas.

In DI there four sets of five questions which were based on tables(all). The questions were easy and direct some of the question were directly from PT material.

In Data Sufficiency section there were 20 questions on 4 option twister type DS. Question were easy and most of the questions can be solved by the statement (A) alone.

In Business Judgement section there were no questions from BJ and all the questions from Logical Reasoning. There were total 20 questions. All questions from Data Arrangement. two/three questions had two correct options.
